

# Rosé vom Zweigelt Frechau 2017

Government inspection number F 15/18

The Frechau vineyard, first mentioned in 1291 as 'Frechau', like the Sandgrube, has consistently loamy soil. Its ability to retain water makes it especially effective during dry years.

Extraction takes place and remains on the mash for only 6 hours.

## Analysis:

12.5 % alcohol by volume  
1.5 g residual sugar  
6.4 % acid

## Tasting:

A lovely, delicate salmon pink with a faint scent of raspberries, blackberries and a slightly herbal nuance. A lively, fruity summer wine.

## Cuisine:

Our Rosé from Zweigelt goes very well with light dishes, such as summer salads, fish dishes, fresh cheeses and the antipasto course.



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
