

Krems Grüner Veltliner Sandgrube 2020

Government inspection number N 333/21

The Krems sand pit, first mentioned in 1215 as 'Sandgrub', consists mainly of loamy fine sand with coarse fractions of crushed stone and gravel in the subsoil. A moderate sloping toward the south offers ideal conditions, especially for the Green Veltliner.

Due to its high-water retention capacity even in dry years, the soil provides the vines with plenty of water.

Analysis:

12,5 alcohol by volume
1,4 g residual sugar
6,4 % acid

Tasting:

Lean minerality, yellow apples, cured tobacco. Peppercorns, lively and fruity acidity, but also has a robust body. Consistently rich and nuanced, a robust and exceptional yet characteristic Veltliner with remarkable staying power.

Cuisine:

Ideally suited to spicy dishes and cheese.



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
